Mr BAYLEY question to MINISTER for PARKS and HERITAGE

My question is from my constituent Di, who has a particular interest and expertise in strata titles. Living in strata is a new style of living for most Tasmanians. It will play an increasing role as we develop our housing stock and increase medium density in our cities, amongst other things. Significant strides are being taken interstate to improve the rules governing living in strata, which Tasmania is well placed to learn from as we move forward in this area. The *Tasmanian Strata Titles Act* is long overdue for reform and an October 2023 review process seems to have come to a halt. When will the Government refresh and activate the current review of the Act? When will the review be completed and how will a rebooted review engage with the community to improve clarity around the rights and obligations of owners, residents and other stakeholders?
