My constituent writes: as a group of regular harness racing patrons mainly situated at Mowbray, we have a rather large concern as to the safety of some patients with disabilities who are confined to wheelchairs and also walking aids. We have witnessed on two occasions fires where we've had to leave the building with no accessible access. Our question is why is there no accessible access to the ground floor other than the lift, which cannot be used during a fire, and several flights of stairs, which is impossible to get out with a disability?
