

Bass Highway Crashes

Dr BROAD question to MINISTER for INFRASTRUCTURE and TRANSPORT

A number of constituents have raised serious concerns with me about the frequency of crashes on the Bass Highway and, in particular, on the Don Hill between Waverley and Cutts Roads. As the minister would be aware, it took six months to complete repairs on a section of the barrier, only for another crash to occur within two weeks, but I note that it was repaired within less than 24 hours, which was a massive improvement. Has the government undertaken any formal investigation of this section of road and, if so, what were the findings and, if not, why not? Further, what specific actions will the government be taking to address the ongoing safety risks?
