## Workplace Culture Oversight

### MEETING COMMUNIQUE

Tuesday, 14 April 2026

The Joint Sessional Committee on Workplace Culture Oversight (the Committee) met today.

Mr Andrew Young, Independent Consultant to the Committee, provided a briefing update on the following Motion for Respect (MFR) recommendations:

1. Provisional results and analysis by the survey consultant (MFR Rec 12). A more comprehensive report of the results of the survey will be provided to the Committee.
2. A draft induction and training analysis and plan (framework) for Members of Parliament (MFR Rec(s) 7&8) was provided for consideration by the Committee.
3. Independent Consultant's Draft Report (MFR Rec 13).

The Committee resolved to invite the Clerks to attend a meeting to discuss the draft framework (MFR Rec(s) 7&8).

The Committee is scheduled to meet next on Thursday, 7 May 2026.

The Committee notes the importance of this review and encourages employees across each employee group to become fully informed and engaged to collectively work towards providing a better workplace for all employees.

The Committee further notes that change can be challenging and commits to providing ongoing updates to inform all interested parties.
