SUBMISSIONS NOW OPEN FOR INQUIRY INTO THE COMMUNITY PROTECTION (OFFENDER REPORTING) AMENDMENT BILL 2025 (No. 61 of 2025)

Friday, 24 April 2026

On 26 March 2026 the House of Assembly referred to the Standing Committee on Government Administration B the Community Protection (Offender Reporting) Amendment Bill 2025 (No. 61 of 2025). The referral proposed the following: -

- (1) That the Community Protection (Offender Reporting) Amendment Bill 2025 (No.61) be referred to the Standing Committee on Government Administration Committee B for inquiry and report thereon.*
- (2) The Committee report by 27 October 2026.*

The Committee now invites interested persons or organisations to make written submissions to the Committee by the closing date of **Friday, 5 June 2026**. As a 'Bill Inquiry' the Committee will be limited in its recommendations to the individual clauses of the Bill, rather than general comment on public policy. An advertisement calling for submissions will be placed in the three regional newspapers on Saturday, 2 May 2026.
