Now that a preferred site has been proposed for the new Child and Family Learning Centre at Smithton, how can locals have a say on the design of the new centre and the services it will offer?

ANSWER:

Thank you for your question on 15 April 2026 regarding the Smithton CFLC and how locals in the community can become involved. The new CFLC in Smithton will offer a variety of services to support families in the Circular Head region.

Locals can have their say on the new CFLC through an online survey, open until 22 May 2026. A community workshop will also be held on Wednesday 20 May from 9.15am at the Circular Head Community and Recreation Centre (72-98 Nelson Street, Smithton).
