COMMITTEE WORKPLAN - JOINT STANDING COMMITTEE ON GREYHOUND TRANSITION

Thursday, 28 May 2026

On Monday, 25 May 2026 the Joint Standing Committee on Greyhound Racing Transition resolved to initiate its new workplan. The workplan was established to guide the Committee's work within its existing Terms of Reference, as established by the Houses of the Parliament of Tasmania.

The workplan is as follows:

- 1. An examination of other jurisdictions, including any parliamentary or statutory inquiries, decisions to phase out the industry, transition frameworks implemented, animal welfare issues, support for participants, compensation arrangements, timelines followed and social and economic impacts;**
- 2. Financial, economic and animal welfare impacts of the proposed phase out of greyhound racing in Tasmania; and**
- 3. The future of the Tasmanian racing Deed.**

The Committee has commenced work in line with the workplan above and will provide more information as it becomes available.
