



House of Assembly Select Committee on Caretaker Conventions

Amended Terms of Reference

On Wednesday 12 August 2026, the House of Assembly –

Ordered – That the Terms of Reference of the Select Committee on Caretaker Conventions be amended to read as follows:

- (1) A select committee be appointed with power to send for persons, papers and records to inquire into, consider and report on the Tasmanian Government's adherence to Caretaker Conventions along with any other relevant codes, regulations or laws during Tasmanian elections held since 1 January 2024 including but not limited to the following decisions and activities:-
 - (a) intergovernmental agreement to progress Project Marinus;
 - (b) Tasracing's promotion of the Liberal Party election commitment 'TasInsure';
 - (c) TT-Line financial assistance;
 - (d) the decision for Government funds to be spent advertising with Pulse Tasmania; and
 - (e) any other matters incidental thereto.
- (2) The following Members be appointed to serve on the Committee:
 - (a) one Member nominated by the Leader of the House;
 - (b) one Member nominated by the Leader of Opposition Business;
 - (c) one Member nominated by the Leader of the Greens; and
 - (d) the Honourable Member for Braddon, Mr *Craig Garland* MP.
- (3) The committee report by 1 September 2026.

Establishing Resolution

On Wednesday 18 March 2026, the House of Assembly –

Ordered – That:-

- (4) A select committee be appointed with power to send for persons, papers and records to inquire into, consider and report on the Tasmanian Government's adherence to Caretaker Conventions along with any other relevant codes, regulations or laws during the 2025 State Election, including but not limited to the following decisions and activities:-
 - (f) intergovernmental agreement to progress Project Marinus;
 - (g) Tasracing's promotion of the Liberal Party election commitment 'TasInsure';
 - (h) TT-Line financial assistance;
 - (i) the decision for Government funds to be spent advertising with Pulse Tasmania; and
 - (j) any other matters incidental thereto.
- (5) The following Members be appointed to serve on the Committee:
 - (e) one Member nominated by the Leader of the House;
 - (f) one Member nominated by the Leader of Opposition Business;
 - (g) one Member nominated by the Leader of the Greens; and
 - (h) the Honourable Member for Braddon, Mr *Craig Garland* MP.
- (6) The committee report by 1 September 2026.
