Dear Mrs Greene

On March 18th you asked me the following question,

“Jean in Prospect would like to know if the Premier can confirm there is a new kitchen installed in the Heritage Tasmania meeting room in the public buildings in Launceston? What was the cost of this new kitchen? How many metres away is the nearest kitchen on the same floor and why doesn't the Premier want to share the nearest kitchen with his ministers?”

In response I can confirm the following

- Heritage Tasmania, the Department of Premier and Cabinet (DPAC) and Ministerial and Parliament Services (MPS) are located on the Ground Floor of 53 St John Street, Launceston.
- There are two kitchens located on the ground floor.
- Heritage Tasmania and DPAC share one facility, and the other kitchen is used by MPS Ministers and staff.
- On the first floor, the Premier, three Ministers and MPS staff have access to one kitchen.
- No changes or upgrades have been made to the location of the two kitchens on the Ground Floor over the past 18 months since the relocation of Heritage Tasmania

I trust this information assists you in responding to your constituent's concerns.
