MEETING COMMUNIQUE
Thursday, 7 May 2026

The Joint Sessional Committee on Workplace Culture Oversight (the Committee) met today and received a briefing from the Clerks of the Parliament and Executive Director, Legislature-General in relation to the draft induction and training framework for Members of Parliament (Motion for Respect Report (MFR) Recommendations 7&8) and an overall progress update against MFR Recommendations.

The Committee also received a draft in progress report from the Independent Consultant on the results of the survey and comparison with Anti-Discrimination Commissioner's survey of 2021 (MFR Recommendation 12).

The Committee is scheduled to meet next on Tuesday, 19 May 2026.

The Committee notes the importance of this review and encourages employees across each employee group to become fully informed and engaged to collectively work towards providing a better workplace for all employees.
