

## Social Housing – Accessibility Modifications

### **Ms BROWN question to PREMIER**

My constituent, Cindy Eyles, lives in a Mission Australia home. Ms Eyles is under enormous stress, adjusting to the cancer diagnosis, treatment and compromised mobility of her adult son.

Ms Eyles' son has six more weeks of hospital treatment for a rare form of cancer before he can go home. Before this can happen, their home needs to be modified to be wheelchair accessible. As he is not suitable for out-of-home disability care or a group home option, Ms Eyles reports that Mission Australia told her directly that they are under no obligation to accommodate her son's disability requirements.

Noting your Health minister's repeated attempts to place blame for bed block on the federal government not finding solutions for aged care patients, will you guarantee Ms Eyles the upgrades to her home to be made in time, so her son does not have to remain in hospital indefinitely?
